LA HOTEL WORKERS SPEAK OUT



Eyes on 11 recently shined a spotlight on a union-backed policy that would force hotels to house homeless individuals. To get the perspective of hotel workers who would be directly impacted by such a policy, we invited those in the Los Angeles area to weigh in on current issues impacting their industry, including the potential for hotels to house the homeless. Below are the responses of 56 self-identified hotel workers.*

Question 1:

Do you support the ongoing strike at area hotels?

1. Strongly Support	46.4%
2. Somewhat Support	8.9%
3. Somewhat Oppose	3.6%
4. Strongly Oppose	10.7%
5. No Opinion	30.3%

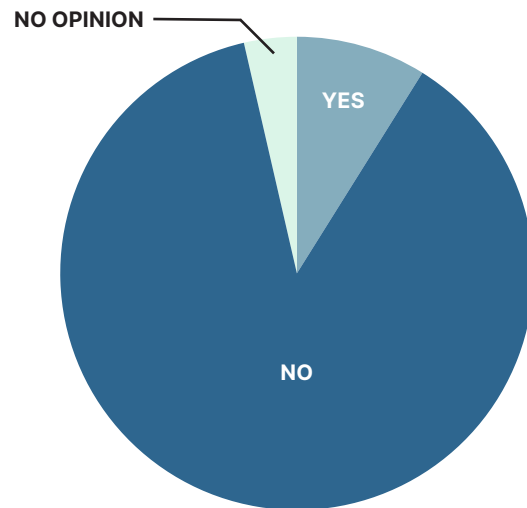
Question 3:

If hotels housed the homeless, how would it impact worker safety?

1. Much Safer	1.8%
2. Somewhat Safer	0%
3. No Change	5.3%
4. Somewhat Less Safe	19.6%
5. Much Less Safe	73.2%

Question 2:

Would you support requiring hotels to house homeless individuals?



1. Yes	8.9%
2. No	87.5%
3. No Opinion	3.6%
